

quick start guide HeinOnline Law Journals

HeinOnline law journal collection contains over 1,600 law and law-related journals. Coverage of these full-text journals varies, but many are available from the first issue right up to the most recent one. HeinOnline also provides access to English Reports.

Location

HeinOnline can be found in the electronic resources A-Z list. There is also a link to it on the databases list on the Law subject page.

Click on the blue Quick Links **Databases** link on the right of the Library homepage. Click on **H** from the A-Z list. Scroll down and click on the **HeinOnline** link.

You will then see the University of Bolton's **Electronic Resources Login**. Login with your Bolton network ID and password.

Click on Law Journal Library.

Searching



You can use HeinOnline's **Quick Search** box or explore the other search options such as Advanced Search and Citation Navigator.

You can choose to browse the journal titles available using the A-Z list. You can choose to browse by title, subject etc.

Click on the information icon by each title for further details about the journal.

Results

You can save or email an article by clicking on Save to MyHein or Print/Download Options.

You must have registered for a **MyHein** account via the top toolbar in order to save to it. See below.

Sorting Results



The results are sorted by relevance by default. But you can change this by clicking on the drop down arrow shown above and selecting another option. You can also refine your results by running another search within the results set.

ScholarCheck

ScholarCheck is integrated into the search results. If you see a **Cited by...** link, you can click on that to view the articles that cite the article you are viewing.



Access an article

Click an article title to access the full text.



You can access the pages that contain your search terms directly by clicking on **All Matching Text Pages**. You can print or download the article.

Page Navigation

When you are viewing an article within the database, each page displays individually and you must move to the next page using the arrows at the top or bottom of the screen. It is easier to scroll through an article after downloading as a pdf.

Citations on Page

When you are reading an article online it is possible to link directly to article cited in the text if they are available via HeinOnline.



Full-Text access

Most journals in the collection are fully accessible. However, there are a few that are citation and abstract only for the past year or 18 months. If you wish to access an article that is abstract only, you can order it via the online Inter-Library Loans service www.bolton.ac.uk/library/Borrowing/Inter-Library-Loans.aspx.

MyHein

You can create your own account within HeinOnline to save searches, bookmark favourite journals or articles.
